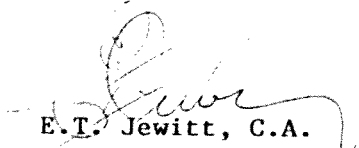
Order Pursuant to Section 77

Temporary Order Pursuant to Section 77

WHEREAS AFC Energy Corporation (formerly American Fluorite Corporation) (the Company), has failed to file an annual audited financial statement for the year ended December 31, 1982 and an interim financial statement for the 6 month period ended June 30, 1983 with the Superintendent of Brokers (Superintendent) as required;

AND WHEREAS it would appear the Company has failed to hold an Annual General Meeting since May 21, 1982 as required;

NOW THEREFORE the Superintendent being of the opinion that the length of time required for a hearing could be prejudicial to the public interest HEREBY ORDERS, pursuant to Section 77 of the Securities Act, that trading in the securities of AFC Energy Corporation shall cease forthwith for a period of 15 days from the date hereof, but this ORDER, may be further extended or sooner rescinded on receipt of satisfactory information by the Superintendent.
