A.O.G. Air Support Inc. is a reporting issuer and has not filed:

1. a comparative financial statement for its financial year ended September 30, 2005, as required under Part 4 of National Instrument 51-102 (NI 51-102), and
2. a Form 51-102F1 *Management's Discussion and Analysis* for the period ended September 30, 2005, as required under Part 5 of NI 51-102.

(the required records).

The Insider may have knowledge of, or access to, a material fact or material change regarding A.O.G. Air Support Inc. that has not been generally disclosed.

A.O.G. Air Support Inc. has agreed to file, immediately after this order is granted, the Notice of Default and, if applicable, Default Status Reports, set out in CSA Staff Notice 57-301 *Failing to File Financial Statements on Time - Management Cease Trade Orders*.

Under section 164(1) of the Act, the Executive Director orders that all trading by the Insider in the securities of A.O.G. Air Support Inc. cease until:

1. A.O.G. Air Support Inc. files the required records, completed in accordance with the Act and rules, and
2. the Executive Director makes an order under section 164 of the Act revoking this order.
